Internship opportunity: We offer a research internship or individual course to contribute research projects in collaboration with the International Water Management Research Institute ([IWMI](#) – West Africa office) 2023-2024. This study address key topics relate to

- *Review on citizen science-based approaches for building climate resilience through water management in agricultural landscapes in Sub Sahara Africa*

Methodology will be a desk- based literature review on published peer reviewed articles. The study will be designed with supervisor at SLU and IWMI jointly. Estimated full time 4-6 weeks, but can be undertaken as parttime, in agreement with supervisor.

Terms and conditions

- The candidates should have at least year 3 and commencing MSc, up to newly graduated at MSc, with fluent English.
- Studies should be related to agricultural-forestry soil and water management and crop production, water engineering, natural resources management, rural development or related topics.
- The study will be published as a report (max 20p) and must be completed as final draft by 10th Dec 2024.
