Dear Dean Prof. Niskanen,

On behalf of the ECOVE, which met on 29 May 2024, I hereby inform you of the outcome of the evaluation based on the ESEVT Full Visitation to your VEE on 18-22 March 2024.

The Committee concluded that the following Major Deficiencies had been identified:

- 1. Non-compliance with Standard 9.2. because the number and range of skills of teaching staff at the VTH-pet clinic are insufficient.
- 2. Non-compliance with Standard 9.4 because of insufficient involvement of teaching staff in designing the VTH's contribution to clinical teaching and research and in its day-to-day management.

In accordance with the European System of Evaluation of Veterinary Training (ESEVT) and based on the educational requirements of the Directive 2005/36/EC as amended by Directive 2013/55/EU.

## the status of the VEE of the Swedish University of Agricultural Sciences is PENDING ACCREDITATION

Please note that the Re-visitation **must be performed two years after the previous Full Visitation at the latest** and can only be performed once; if this interval is exceeded, only a Full Visitation can be planned. Please also note that the Re-visitation **must be requested within one year after the Full Visitation**.

The status of Pending Accreditation is valid for the period between the ECOVE decision after the Full Visitation and the subsequent Re-visitation. In case the VEE does not meet the deadlines for requesting and/or undergoing the Re-visitation or if the Re-visitation confirms that the Major Deficiency/ies has/have not been corrected, the status of Pending Accreditation will automatically revert to Non-Accreditation, with validity period starting from the date of the Full Visitation.

Further details about the Re-visitation process can be found in section 2, Chapter 2 of the SOP.
