

Global perspectives on adaptive wildlife management

PhD course, 7.5 ECTS

An interdisciplinary course, comparing adaptive wildlife management in northern and southern hemisphere systems, including a 16-day field trip to South Africa (5–20 January, 2019)

Application deadline: September 1, 2018



There is no course fee but students are expected to cover their travel to/from Johannesburg and contribute to accommodation costs.

Students must be admitted to a doctoral program, ideally in a subject relevant to wildlife management. Each prospective student shall present a brief CV and a motivation of no more than 200 words, outlining how this course will benefit their PhD studies.
